CORONER'S OFFICE UNIDENTIFIED CASE

Public's help needed to identify man found in Land Park area Coroner Case #12-01716

An adult male was found by passersby on Wednesday, April 11. Paramedics and Sacramento Police responded, however, the man was declared deceased at 5:32 p.m. There was no evidence of trauma or foul play. He may have collapsed several hours or the day prior.

The Coroner's Office believes that based on his attire, he was jogging/walking prior to death (ear buds and MP3 player with him; holding a small canister of pepper spray). He may live in the nearby area. He had no identification on him.

Location: Railroad tracks west of San Mateo Way and San Mateo Court, Sacramento

Description: Male, Caucasian
Estimated age 50-60
5'10"; 170 lbs
Blue eyes
Brown/gray hair; cut short on the sides/back, with balding on the top
Scar on the top of head; no other scars or tattoos

Clothing description: Blue shorts, gray s/l t-shirt with "Bomb Squad" logos front and back; blue l/s t-shirt with "UC Davis" and medical symbol logos, blue Eddie Bauer brand jacket; white "NYPD" logo briefs, white socks, white/blue New Balance brand athletic shoes, white metal frame sunglasses, dark colored knit cap with "Cabela's" logo; dark colored neck gator, bandage-type wrap around left wrist.

Jewelry: Black cord necklace with a Star of David pendant.
